LETTER FROM DWIGHT

Lead Pastor

Sugarcreek Free Methodist was birthed out of tent revivals in Sugarcreek, Ohio. Earl and Anna Hershberger were some of the charter members who established the church. They came to know Jesus, left their Amish lifestyle, and gave their time and money to build a church that would call people to a life of holiness. They were shunned by their families, consequently, but Earl and Anna believed that God wanted to save thousands of people in their community.

Dwight Mason, a 24-year-old pastor, was "temporarily" assigned to Sugarcreek Free Methodist Church. Although his time was supposed to be limited, he has continued to be our lead pastor for the last 37 years.

The church relocated to the current location in Dover on State Route 39 and grew from 1,600 to 3,000 in attendance. Sugarcreek Free Methodist was renamed as NewPointe Community Church at the time of the move.

The congregation moved into their new building on Dover Road in Sugarcreek. Earl and Anna personally purchased the land for the building.



SPOTLIGHT ON CAMPUSES

CAMBRIDGE

Volunteered at the Guernsey County Night Out, which connects public safety and community partners. Was also involved with Treats on the Trail, helping foster relationships between NewPointe and young families.

CANTON

Additions of new ministries areas that include a Young Adults Group, Retirees Lunch, and Student Services. Opened Kids Play Area that is used both on weekends and during the week.

COSHOCTON

Served the surrounding community by hosting senior adults breakfasts, quarterly blood drives, and GriefShare® groups. Opened Kids Play Area that is used both on weekends and during the week.

DOVER

Launched Kids Sports Ministry, Armor Sports, with camps over the summer and a full season of basketball and cheer. Hosted a Challenger Baseball banquet/dance for adults and kids with special needs, which impacted hundreds of families.

MILLERSBURG

Partnered with Love INC, which has helped care for people of this community spiritually, emotionally, relationally, and physically. Hosted "IF" women's conference in the spring, which many in the area attended.

WOOSTER

Participated in the Wayne County Fair by hosting a booth and interacting with hundreds of individuals to share about NewPointe and invite them to a service. Continued remodeling and improvements of many areas on campus including Kids theater, nursery, roofing, and paint for the exterior.





WHAT IS OUR GOAL?

Primary Goal

100% ENGAGEMENT

Our dream is that every person at NewPointe would acknowledge and declare Jesus is FIRST in every aspect of their lives. We are calling everyone to think differently about how we view the possessions and resources God has entrusted to our care.

The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. Colossians 1:15-17 NIV

How should we respond to such an amazing reality? Do we have unsurrendered areas of our lives? Does our faith and trust in Jesus need to be revitalized? What are areas we MUST grow in? Have we given our very best to the One who gave us His life?

We want every person to take his/her next step in their faith and generosity by making Iesus FIRST.

Secondary Goal

\$26 MILLION

As we all join to put God before all things in our lives, we are trusting Him to move through each one of us to give \$26 million over the next two years. We will invest these resources in three areas to impact the kingdom.

\$18M: OPERATIONAL BUDGET

This covers the lifeblood of what we do every day and represents our annual two-year operational budget. We will invest in our ongoing ministries and trust God to continue to move and produce life change in our kids, students, and adults at NewPointe.

\$5.5M: POTENTIAL COMMUNITY INITIATIVES

KIDS/STUDENTS CAMPS

We believe God is calling us to invest in the next generation, and we know that when kids and students are able to remove distractions and spend a few days hearing God's voice, EVERYTHING can change. We want to be able to offer CAMPS at a fraction of the cost. We plan to send KIDS (Grades 3-5) to camp for \$50 and STUDENTS (Grades 6-12) for \$99! We do not want cost to be a reason that a kid/student does not attend camp, and possibly experience the presence of God for the first time.

SPECIAL NEEDS MINISTRY

We want to help children and adults with physical, mental, and developmental needs understand God's love for them and to support the family as a whole. We want to provide a safe environment that families will trust, leaving their loved ones in our care to attend weekend services.

EXPLORE A POTENTIAL CAMPUS LOCATION FOR CAMBRIDGE

The Cambridge campus launched in 2019. This campus currently meets in an elementary school, which requires setup and teardown EVERY Sunday. We want to purchase a permanent campus site for this community which would allow us to provide additional resources to the people of Cambridge and surrounding areas.

COMMUNITY NEEDS

We want to be able to provide for needs in the communities around each of our six campuses. Community needs arise throughout the year and we want to have the ability to meet those needs both long term and short term depending on the situation. Some of these areas could include, but are not limited to, local schools, affordable housing, outreach, and public service.

\$2.5M: WORLD

We believe the local church is the hope of the world living and teaching the truth of Jesus Christ, and has the potential and power to bring about real change. We believe God's love and concern extends to all people in every place, and we are living intentionally to build strategic local, national, and global relationships.



IS HE WORTHY?

But you must continue to believe this truth and stand firmly in it. Don't drift away from the assurance you received when you heard the Good News. The Good News has been preached all over the world, and I, Paul, have been appointed as God's servant to proclaim it. Colossians 1:23 NLT

IT IS WORTH THE ...

But part of my work is to suffer for you; and I am glad, for I am helping to finish up the remainder of Christ's sufferings for his body, the Church. Colossians 1:24 TLB

SEEK FIRST ...

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all. Colossians 3:1-11 NIV
