TALK IT OVER

How has your view of your parents changed over the years? What prompted the change? God says you are to honor the position of parenthood no matter how the parent dishonors it. Discuss. What does that look like? Psychology Today states that the number-one goal of modern parents is to teach their children to be independent, assertive, and self-reliant. Forty years ago, the number-one goal of most parents was to impart moral values to their children. As a society we are no longer big on respect for or submission to authority. How do you see evidence of that? How is it affecting society in general? School? Church? Home? How do you see rewards or benefits for honoring parents? When you do not honor your parents, you shame and discredit God. Discuss. When we live at home, we are to honor by obeying and respecting our parents. Talk about what it means to "obey your parents in the Lord." What does demonstrating an inward attitude of respect look like? When we mature and leave home, honoring parents means accepting them and appreciating them. What are meaningful ways to do that? Talk about honoring a parent who is hard to honor. If you are a parent, how can you make it easier to be honored authentically?
