TALK IT OVER

The question is not if God is speaking to us. The question is whether or not we are in a position to hear His voice. Hearing God is the normal experience for children of God. He speaks to His sons and daughters. Does that reflect your experience? When have you recently heard His voice? Hearing God's voice depends on positioning your heart to hear Him. First, a willing heart the condition of surrender. Before we even know what God says, our answer is "Yes." How do we get to that place? Surrender is not loss of freedom; it's the gate to divine direction. Discuss. Second, a clean heart the condition of holiness. Unconfessed sin blocks God's voice. How do you work with God to unblock the channel? Third, a listening heart - the condition of stillness. How do you cultivate stillness? How can you maintain stillness throughout the day? Fourth, a trusting heart - the condition of faith. When God speaks, He rarely reveals the whole picture. We hear when we step forward in faith. When we trust God, our inner life becomes calm enough to recognize His leading. How has this been true for you? Is there an area where He is asking you to do this now? Fifth, a teachable heart - the condition of humility. God speaks to those who are willing to be corrected, redirected, and taught. A proud heart hears only what confirms its own ideas. Where is God asking you to say, "I am ready to follow Your instruction, even if it challenges me?"

ACTION STEP

I want to hear God speak to me. This condition in my heart needs work. I will work with God to get it right.
