TALK IT OVER

Where do you see chaos around you? Currently, what chaos is affecting you most? What is your typical response to chaos? Do you have any past experience you can share when God brought order out of chaos in your life? Instead of despair, God wants us to rest in His might. What practices can remind you that God is bigger than the chaos? What makes you feel unseen and disregarded or unnoticed by God? What can help you rest in the truth that you are never unseen or undervalued? You are not only seen by the Mighty God – He is always with you. How does focusing on that help you? God doesn't worry. He never gets overwhelmed. He's never in a hurry. Does the fact that God's not in a hurry ever bother you? How do you work with that frustration? What testimony in chaos can you share that our Mighty God "gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak"? In the situations around us two action steps we can take are to PRAY to the Mighty God, and then to practically partner with God in bringing order out of chaos for those around us. What do you see that you can do right now for someone? Any special guidelines for helping those who do not know Jesus?

ACTION STEP

I will arrange my schedule to pray and partner with the Mighty God and others specifically for the chaos around me. I will remind myself daily that He is bigger, but He sees me, and His might knows no limits.
