TALK IT OVER

God isn't angry or ashamed of you; He has a tender heart toward you. God is consistently good at being faithful to undeserving people. How have you personally seen God's faithfulness to yourself or others? When Peter saw the power and the faithfulness of Jesus, he surrendered and left everything to follow Him. How does surrender figure into your experiencing the faithfulness that is ever ready? How does lack of surrender impact our ability to see God's faithfulness? How do you know if you are just a believer or if you are truly following Jesus? What are ways we currently might deny Jesus with our lives? How does realizing He is faithful to YOU when you are not to Him impact you? Some can't believe this because they feel it is an invitation to reckless living. Discuss. What has Jesus done in a sensory manner to prove His faithfulness to you? Share your experience with God's faithfulness so far. Identify any area where you want to trust Him more.

ACTION STEP

I will identify any area of my life where I am blocking myself from recognizing and experiencing God's continual faithfulness to me by my lack of surrender. I will leave it all to follow.
