TALK IT OVER

Do you recognize an area from your experience where your perspective has held you back? Discuss. If you want to understand how you view God, listen to how you pray. What do you think your prayers tell you? To pray as Jesus taught us to pray, we have to see God as He truly is, not as we imagine Him to be. How IS God, truly? How does your grown-up version of God differ from your childhood one? How do your prayers demonstrate the change? How do assumptions prevent you from listening and hearing in human relationships? How do assumptions prevent you from hearing and seeing God's perspective? Where does the Holy Spirit prompt you that your assumptions might be keeping you from thinking like Jesus? Our past, personality, and prejudices or preferences are the common filters that keep us from seeing clearly. Where do you see your own struggle? How will I surrender my perspective to God?

ACTION STEP

I will pray daily, "Let the things that break your heart break my heart. Let the things that bring you joy bring me joy. Let me see people as you see people, then give me the wisdom and courage to respond." ___
