Philippians 4:1-20

Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends! (v. 1).

New Resources

1.	peace.
	I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord (v. 2).
2.	your joy.
	Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! (v. 4).
3.	humility.
	Let your gentleness be evident to all (v. 5a).
4.	faith.
	The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything (v. 5b-6a
5.	gratitude.
	In everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God (vv. 6b-7).
6.	right.
	Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things (v. 8).
7.	the standard.
	Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. (v. 9).

New Generosity

1.	Generosity brings
	I rejoiced greatly in the Lord that at last you renewed your concern for me (v. 10).
2.	Generosity teaches us
	I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation (vv. 11-13).
3.	Generosity engages us in
	Yet it was good of you to share in my troubles (v. 14).
4.	Generosity is
	Moreover, as you Philippians know, in the early days of your acquaintance with the gospel, when I set out from Macedonia, not one church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving, except you only (vv. 15-16).
5.	Generosity is
	Not that I desire your gifts; what I desire is that more be credited to your account (v. 17).
6.	Generosity pleases
	I have received full payment and have more than enough. I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God (v. 18).
7.	Generosity unlocks
	And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus (v. 19).
