TALK IT OVER

The temptations to Jesus all offered a short-cut to what we want to have, what we want to do, and what others think of us. Why are short-cuts so appealing? Why are these three temptations so strong for us? How is control a mask for performing? In your life, how have masks hindered your relationships with God and others? Do you find it hard to allow yourself to see yourself authentically here? Why or why not? How are you currently defeating the fears of uncertainty, failure, and rejection? How might you help a fellow struggler?

ACTION STEP

I will take courage from the fact that Satan tempted Jesus in the same way he tempts me. Jesus is uniquely equipped to help me. I will open my whole heart and give my fears to Him in trust and confidence that He will help me.
