#### TALK IT OVER

What does it mean that parenting is about being a steward? How is that different from the average perception of parenting? What makes this such a struggle for most parents. The first step of parenting is to recognize your purpose. The purpose of parenting: Nothing is more important in your life than being one of God's tools to form a human soul. What evidence do you have that we "form human souls" whether or not we do it intentionally? Andy Stanley says, "If you want to change someone, hurt them deeply or love them profoundly." Discuss how this applies to parenting. How do we steward grace and truth? The second step is to realize you are powerless. Do you think most parents feel powerless? How is feeling powerless different than recognizing you are powerless? God never calls you to a task without giving you what you need to do it. He never sends you without going with you. How can this be applied to parenting? Tim Elmore says three power tools are fear, reward, and shame. Discuss these. How has God helped you? If you were raised by godly parents, how did your parents access the power of God for you? How will you pray for the parents of our Gen Z young people?
