# TALK IT OVER

Fear of the unknown is most likely the greatest fear in every generation. How is that true or untrue in your life? What fears Joseph and Mary must have experienced are familiar to you as well? Trusting God when I don't know the outcome is challenging. How does knowing God is with you help you? What promises does God make that remind you He is with you when you fear the unknown? How do you handle the power of the "what-ifs" that come to your mind? How can you actively stop "feeding the monster"? When I act on my fears I am agreeing with the Enemy. Ouch. Discuss. God doesn't simply watch from a distance -- He comes near. How can you intentionally participate in raising your awareness that God is near and with you when fear knocks? How is knowing God through Christ in an ongoing transformative personal relationship impacting your fears right now? God has promised He will never leave us or forsake us (Hebrews 13:5). Where do I need to trust RIGHT NOW that God is with me?
