TALK IT OVER

Jesus has called and actually commanded every follower to be a fisher of men and a disciple maker. Discuss what you see as the defining characteristics of a fisher of men and a disciple maker. Can you be obedient to Jesus and only do one of those? As a disciple of Jesus, I should yearn to make disciples. Discuss your passion for that. How is that passion exhibited? Viral disciple-making happens in ordinary living. It happens as we 1) Believe in the authority of Jesus. How does fully believing in His authority impact the process? 2) Obey the command of Christ. What does obedience look like? 3) Depend upon the presence of Christ. Confidence in the constant presence of Jesus turns your everyday activities, your ordinary life, into disciple making. Discuss how you can use your ordinary life, the opportunities you currently have, and the people currently in your life to make disciples. Disciple making is simply showing people how to follow Jesus.
