TALK IT OVER

Giving up your faith doesn't make life easier. It makes it more complicated. Discuss. Each person has a different race marked out for them. Why is this hard to remember and how does it impact me when I forget? The only way to deal with our circumstances is to fix our eyes on Jesus. How have you experienced that? When have you found "mercy and grace to help you in your time of need"?

ACTION STEP

I will daily focus my eyes on Jesus through worship and obedience. I will have more faith in Him than fear of my circumstances. He will always be my go-to.
