TALK IT OVER

Jesus is the One who made the dramatic statement that believing is not enough – "even the demons do that." What's the difference between believing He is who He said He is and trusting Him for salvation? Talk about the difference between trusting for salvation and actually following Jesus. What does it mean to order your life around His kingdom values? What does it mean to truly embrace His vision, values, and culture? How have you found following to be costly? Fulfilling? Is there an area you particularly struggle to embrace truly following? The name "Christian" in our culture doesn't inspire faith in us any more than it did in the days of the early church. We easily identify as "Christian," but less easily and accurately as Paul did, as a "follower of the way." Do you feel comfortable identifying yourself as a Jesus-follower or follower of the way in settings other than church? Explain. Discuss the difference between being convinced and committed. How are you ordering your life around following, learning, and becoming like Jesus?
