## TALK IT OVER

Can you remember a moment when you truly felt invisible? How about a moment when you truly felt seen? How does feeling "seen" or "unseen" feel to you? What factors do you think made Hagar feel invisible? How did God make her aware that she was seen? What did God understand about her? How did He protect her? How did He treasure her? In your life – do you feel seen by God? Is it a struggle? Discuss. How does God show you He understands you? When have you realized God protects you? We often don't have the vision to see the God who sees us until we are in a vulnerable position. Discuss. If you agree, why do you think it is so? Perhaps knowing God treasures us is hardest of all to believe. What does it mean to be treasured by God, and how do you experience it? When we are seen by God, we **see** God. Hebrews 12:2-3 says that we see God by fixing our eyes on Jesus. What does that mean? How do we now truly see others?
