## TALK IT OVER

Jesus introduced the unheard-of idea that God loves everyone equally and compassion must be extended to all. They did not believe that compassion was always necessary. Where do you see evidence of that opinion today? How do you see Jesus giving dignity to everyone? *While we may be criticized for what we believe, we should be known for our compassion and generosity.* What would that look like for the church? Individually? That is how Jesus and the New Testament Church changed their culture. We can start in our sphere of influence to 1) be the change we want to see 2) value people by connecting 3) add value by influence 4) attract by living good values 5) transform by sharing good values 6) give hope by telling our story. Think of a person in your sphere who needs to know Jesus. At what stage are you with them? What can you do now to help them experience God's love through you? What is the importance of "gentleness and respect" in 1 Peter 3:15 as we tell our stories? Paul said the most important thing we do is share our personal story of God's grace. How can you prioritize sharing yours?
