TALK IT OVER

The fact that the God of the Universe comforts us in our waiting is a miracle in itself. Have you experienced that? If so, share. What helps you in the waiting? How can you encourage someone else who is waiting for their miracle?

ACTION STEP

I will not give up on praying for the desires I believe God has placed in my heart. But I will surrender to His best answer and will copy and keep Psalm 16:5-11 to read regularly while I wait. I will encourage myself in the Lord.
