And when your children ask you, "What does this ceremony mean to you?" then tell them, "It is the Passover sacrifice to the Lord, who passed over the houses of the Israelites in Egypt and spared our homes when he struck down the Egyptians." Then the people bowed down and worshiped. Exodus 12:26-27 NIV

After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, "Take this and divide it among you. For I tell you I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." TALK IT OVER

What's something spiritually you tend to forget? How is forgetfulness costly in relationships? In our relationship with God? What helps you on a daily basis remember the presence of God? Forgetting God can cost us our character, peace, freedom, relationships. Discuss. When we forget, we try to earn God's love instead of experiencing it. When and how have you experienced that? How would you explain the significance of the Passover meal to someone who hasn't heard of it? When Jesus changed the focus of the Passover meal from the Exodus to Him, the shock value would be comparable to if the President or other leader said we would now celebrate Christmas as his birthday. What must have the disciples thought? Which of the four promises represented by the cups is most meaningful to you right now? Salvation, Freedom, Restoration, or Fulfillment? Why? How is your relationship more intimate than it was at the start?
