#### TALK IT OVER

What's your typical expectation surrounding Palm Sunday? What do you think might have been the average expectation for Passover week in Jesus' day? Jesus was extremely popular on that Sunday, and a white horse was the ride for a conquering hero. Jesus rode in on a donkey, a symbol of peace. BUT He was claiming to be King. Do you think the people saw the significance? Why or why not? Jesus definitely had courage. Ever since Lazarus' raising, Jesus had kept away from the crowds. Why did He publicly come into Jerusalem now? Why did it take courage? What do you believe was on Jesus' mind when He wept over Jerusalem? Where were they looking for peace? Where do we look for peace? He called them, but they ignored Him, the Source of and path to peace. Jesus explained in every day and every age that we don't hear Him and can't find peace when our hearts become calloused. How does that happen? How is God's call to us like radio waves? How do we make time and space to "tune in"? Where are you currently on the path to peace?

#### **ACTION STEP**

Jesus is the path to peace. He is calling me to fully claim Him as my King and courageously answer His call. I will intentionally give myself time and space this week to tune in to Him and hear His voice.
