TALK IT OVER

What illustrations do you see of God working through generations? Who sowed the seeds of faith in you? God has always planned for the transfer of faith to be multi-generational and intentional. Is this a new thought to you, or are you working and praying for an impact? Discuss the characteristics of the Next Generation. How do you observe them in the young people around you? *Spiritually open, Age of anxiety, Looking for answers, Longing to make a difference.* What are the entry points for each of these? What are the resistance points? The message is to “declare His mighty works”—who He is and what He has done. What can you share? What are the ways you can intentionally “declare”? Silence is the enemy of spiritual inheritance. Discuss. If we do not cast a vision that is bigger and better, we risk losing an entire generation. It’s more than they don’t follow—they won’t even believe.” The home and the church must work together. How does that happen best? How are you participating? How can you invest more?
