TALK IT OVER

It is normal and natural to conform and not make waves. Commitment requires intentionality and focus. Have you intentionally prepared for 2026? If so, how? **My commitments show my priorities.** How do your calendar and checkbook show them? **My priorities show my heart.** Truth is, we all do what we truly want or think is most important. That's ouchy to admit. Discuss.

My priorities determine my destiny. No one ends up anywhere by accident. How are your choices determining your life destiny (health, family, finances, etc.)? How are they determining your eternity? Has your commitment to Christ so far cost you more or less than you expected? Explain. How is commitment to time with God first thing in the morning working out for you? If mornings are impossible for you, how can you work it out otherwise? A Sabbath is necessary for every follower. How do you keep a Sabbath for your priority relationship? What if your job requires Sunday work? Giving first with our finances shows our deep priorities. How would you explain that to someone who has not experienced or chosen to do that? If I am truly committed, God and His Word/plans will have first place in all my decisions. How do you know when you are not getting this right? What can you do to avoid distractions and refuse complacency and be truly counter-cultural?
