How significant is it to "speak to the mountain? How do you do that? Doubt doesn't defeat unless it dominates. How do you fight doubt? What is the mountain standing in your way? Doubt often begins with doubting your identity because that messes with your prayers and discourages you. How can you hold on to your identity in Christ? Faith responds like the answer is already delivered before it shows up. How can you authentically do that? What do you do when you don't get the answer when you truly trusted God and obeyed? What does THAT mean?
