### TALK IT OVER

Is it easier for you to pray to Jesus or God, the Father? Explain. If you struggle with God as your Father, you will struggle with everything else that follows in the prayer. Discuss. Why is this foundational to our surrender and trust? We usually don't come to God to surrender; we usually come to be rescued from something we would have avoided had we surrendered. Agree/disagree? Why? Surrender is an invitation to a way of life that can be experienced in no other way. How have you experienced this? Why do you think for most of us it still continues to be a struggle? Jesus taught us to pray from provision, pardon, and protection. How is each of those dependent on our surrender? Do you genuinely want to be delivered from temptation? We lead ourselves into temptation and then ask God to deliver us from evil. Tough question: How is God speaking to you about your daily surrender in these areas?
