# **TALK IT OVER**

The question for us is, "How much does my life look like Jesus?" We can grow more like Jesus, reflecting God's image, when we are shaped by God's Word, our mirror. We must decide our most trustworthy source of reality. External truth must be greater than internal truth. What does that mean? How do you respond to the common advice, "Just follow your heart?" Explain. Deciding that the Bible is truly God's authoritative truth for my life is an important step toward finding security, significance, and acceptance. How has it impacted your life? Dave shared the research on measurable results of consistently prioritizing time to read God's Word. What are some of the results of God's Word in your life? We struggle to trust God because we doubt His goodness. Discuss. How significant is believing God is good when you are in very difficult times? What are the signs we are not trusting His goodness? In your life, have you experienced adoption as God's child? If so, how is your perception of yourself different? How is God using His Word to shape your life today? What is your consistent plan from now on for "looking into the mirror"?

#### ACTION STEP

I will no longer believe the myth that I must please others to be loved. I will no longer mask myself to hide the real me. I will fashion my life as a child of God, daily looking to His mirror, the Word, for my truth.
