TALK IT OVER

We receive from God so we can release for God – for His kingdom. How does your heart instinctively respond to that statement? God says He has made us rich in every good way so we can ALWAYS be generous. That's not the typical stance of even Christian people. Why do you think we want to "give" but resist being generous? How do you see the distinction? Generosity isn't something we do to become spiritual – it is something we do because God has already been generous to us. Where do you recognize His generosity to you? How does our generosity show the world what God is like? Examples? Discuss: In a culture of a "me first" mentality, generosity is a light that draws people to Christ. How have you personally felt the struggle of materialism? Greed is an ugly word, and we refuse to use it about ourselves. But where have you honestly felt the pull of greed (wanting more and better) in your own heart? How are you intentionally fighting the pull of greed (Jesus said it is the root of all evil) in your life? How has God been faithful to you? How important is it to give intentionally, not emotionally? Generosity is transforming. Whose generosity has been transforming to you?

ACTION STEP

God's generosity to me is incomprehensible. This week I will seek His will and His heart for my generosity.
