#### **TALK IT OVER**

Fear is the by-product of our ability to accumulate knowledge and project into the future. How does that apply to your experience? How does fear rob us? Jesus was always preparing His disciples to conquer fear. Why did He ask them why they were afraid? If Jesus asked you today why you are afraid, what would you answer? The question they asked is the greatest and most important one we all need to ask: "What kind of man is this?" What do you think was their answer? What is yours? After Jesus calmed the sea, their fear of whose presence they were in was greater than their fear of the storm. Discuss. What was the progression of thoughts Peter must have had from stepping into the water until starting to sink? How does fear typically overcome your faith? Jesus came to introduce a faith so big that fear would lose its grip. How is that happening in you? Faith isn't the absence of fear – it is obedience in spite of fear. Where is Jesus calling you to obey and walk on water?
