TALK IT OVER

What does it mean for someone to "get you"? Who in your life has done that very well? What's the difference between certainty and clarity? Why do you think we seek certainty so much? How is desiring certainty a cause of relational problems? Spiritual problems? What is your response to thinking of Jesus having confusion? There are times when confusion is aided by those we love and who love us. (Example: Peter and Jesus) Discuss. What drives us to do that to others? To accept it ourselves? Jesus fought the confusion first by ANCHORING IN TRUTH. Discuss God's Word as a lamp—enough light for the next step. How have you found that true? Jesus ANTICIPATED AND EMBRACED CONFUSION. It increased His dependence on God. How does that work for you? Matthew 26:39 says Jesus PRAYED THROUGH INSTEAD OF PRAYED AWAY. How do you know when to pray away or pray through? How can you keep and strengthen a desire to not short circuit God's plans? Are you willing to trust God for clarity instead of certainty? How will you recognize it?

ACTION STEP

Certainty is no longer my goal except my certainty in Christ. I will anchor myself in God's truth and defeat confusion by embracing it and praying through, starting now with this situation: ____
