## TALK IT OVER

What do you think prompted the disciples to ask Jesus to teach them to pray when they had been raised in the synagogue to pray? What do you think seemed most different about their prayers? Who do you know who prays in such a way that you think they have a special connection? Why? Is the idea of approaching God as Father comforting and empowering or difficult for you? Explain. Real, revealing, relaxed. How well do these words express your communication with God? Discuss. Jesus says to "hit a pause button" when we start to pray and recognize who God is. How well do you do that? Next, we surrender to His will and purpose. Talk about the dailiness of surrender and how you are doing that in your life. Declare your dependency on God. How do you keep this priority when you are busy but there's no crisis? Is it easier for you to pray from the heart when there is no problem or when you are in panic mode? What are the best ways you have learned to stay consistent and fulfilled in your communication with God?
