TALK IT OVER

What were the differences between Jairus and the woman? What did they have in common? With whom do you most identify? Why? When have you been in a place where the things that once worked didn't work anymore? What was that like? What did you do? What does it typically take for you to realize something is too much for you to handle? The woman became identified with her issue. That happens more often than we might think. What might people think is your identity if they read your social media, listen to your conversations, read your thoughts? Is it a true identity? Is it what you want and need your identity to be? If you want God to do something He has never done, He is going to ask you to do something you have never done. Discuss. Is that always true? How do you know? Daughters (and sons) don't beg and plead - they ask and receive. Discuss. What do you do? All who come to Jesus get more than just heaven. What? Jairus was seeing time pass and hope diminish. But Jesus came through for him too. Both learned 1) Trust Jesus, not your plans. 2) Trust Jesus to define reality and truth. 3) Trust Jesus' timing, not yours. What is He trying to teach you? Many touch Jesus, but not everyone is transformed. What makes the difference?
