#### **TALK IT OVER**

Everyone who has been an active part of a church for very long has been hurt by "the church." What has been true for you? What are the reasons you see that people blame God and the church for people's mistakes? Talk about misuse of power in the church. Discuss the need for grace and truth. Jesus didn't balance grace and truth. He was ALL grace and ALL truth. How does humility impact our representation of Him? Acts 2:42-47 is a summary of how God used the church powerfully then and throughout church history: prayer, service, persuasive teaching, and suffering. How do you see those working or lacking in our church and the Church as a whole today? When we do these well, we are bringing Jesus to people. How has that happened for you? What is the difference between knowing Jesus and knowing about Him? How does that change your perspective on the church? Share about someone who is playing the melody imperfectly, but you clearly hear the song of Jesus.

#### **ACTION STEP**

The Church is God's gift me, and I am part of His gift to the world. I will pray for my church, THE Church, and me to use power wisely and operate in grace and truth. I will let go of any hurt I have held.
