TALK IT OVER

How can you be purposefully present while in a deeply dissatisfying situation? When we insert our short-term ideas of what "future" is, we set ourselves up for disappointment with God. Discuss. What do you do/will you do to make certain your hope is solidly in God, not our preferred outcome? What does it mean to seek; to pursue God? What disciplines do you have in place to do that?
