## **TALK IT OVER**

How have you typically thought about faith? What is a new concept you picked up in this study of Hebrews 11:1-6? Faith is the inner conviction that what God says is true, even if it's invisible. How is Jesus Christ Himself the evidence for our faith? What's the difference between faith and trust? Perception is when you hear truth and your mind begins to interact with what you already know - that's thinking. But to become faith, it must go beyond knowing. **Persuasion is** when your emotions become attached to that truth. Where in your faith journey can you identify those stages, perhaps about a specific arena of faith? Performance is when faith enables God to work in my life - my will chooses to respond obediently to what I know and believe. Have you had a harder time believing that God exists or that He rewards? How have you experienced the rewards of seeking Him? Discuss the way in which you are attempting to diligently seek God. What characterizes a life that diligently seeks God?
