# **KEY VERSES AND QUOTES**

How can you say to your brother, "Let me take the speck out of your eye," when all the time there is a plank in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye. Matthew 7:4-5 NIV

#### TALK IT OVER

Is it more difficult for you to be asked to forgive or to ask for forgiveness? Why do you think so? In the story about Frankenstein, "the pain inflicted on his family was because he didn't want to deal with what he had created. In his negligence, more damage was done." Discuss this reality in relational destruction. Whenever any relationship has tension, this is the clearest sign that someone needs to ask for forgiveness. We see and feel the sign – but what makes it difficult to take the step? Why is asking for God's forgiveness not enough? If your list for needing to extend forgiveness is longer than your list for needing to ask forgiveness, you're probably suffering from plank-eye. (3) Why is this so hard to admit? If you have a hard time apologizing, it's either because you have not genuinely experienced God's forgiveness, or you have forgotten how much He has forgiven you. Discuss. What was helpful to you about Dr. Cloud's directives on how to apologize?
