Three Keys to Experiencing Peace:

1. _____ a moment of clarity.

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord. John 20:19-20

2. _____ humility.

God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble. 1 Peter 5:5 ESV

3. _____ Jesus to help me.

"Come to me, all of you who are tired and worn out from carrying heavy loads, and I will give you rest! Yoke up with me and learn from me for I am gentle and humble, and you'll find peace and rest for your soul." Matthew 11:28-29
