This is why . . .

- We are a church of small groups.
- We like to keep children and students with the same small group leader.
- Adults choose their own small groups.

- We give children a *God-Time* card each week.
- Students do a study every year that emphasizes the importance of personal devotions.
- We pass out memory verse cards that coincide with our message notes.
- We offer DISCOVER classes.
- 4. Pivotal _____ (James 1:2-4)

- We show baptism videos in our services.
- We provide mentoring for engaged couples.
- We encourage small groups to stay together for 36 months.
- We keep children and students with the same small group leader for several years.
- 5. Personal _____ (Matthew 14:13-21)

This is why . . .

- We encourage participation on ministry teams.
- We provide opportunities for work teams/short-term mission trips.
- We give students opportunities to serve on Sunday mornings through Student Impact.
- We encourage unbelievers to serve.
