1.	Turn from and do
	Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it. Psalm 34:14 NIV
2.	Enforce
	All you need to say is simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one. Matthew 5:37 NIV
3.	Speak and deal with
	So stop telling lies And "don't sin by letting anger control you." Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, for anger gives a foothold to the devil. Ephesians 4:25-27 NLT

	The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. James 5:16b NIV
