HOW TO LIVE IN GRACE:

1. _____ Jesus Christ as your Savior.

For it is by grace you are saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God, not of works lest any man should boast. Ephesians 2:8-9 NIV

As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him. Colossians 2:6 NKJV

2. _____ yourself daily.

God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.
1 Peter 5:5 NLT

3. _____ close to God daily.

Draw near to God and he will draw near to you.
James 4:8 NKJV

4. _____ your sins.
