### **BIBLICAL ESSENTIALS // BE501 INTRODUCTION TO CHRISTIAN ETHICS**

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course equips the student to develop a personal code of ethics based on a worldview grounded in absolute Biblical truth. Christian ethics are compared and contrasted to other major ethical systems. Critical thinking exercises are applied to contemporary ethical issues.

#### **LEARNING OBJECTIVES**

- Form and enhance a Christian worldview based on the absolute truths of the Bible.
- Explore the presuppositions and claims of other major ethical systems.
- Evaluate the Christian ethical system based on absolute moral truth to other Christian and non-Christian ethical systems.
- Critically apply the Christian ethical system to the evaluation of current moral problems.
- Develop and articulate a personal code of ethics.
- Reflect on the application of this personal code of ethics to daily life.
