

21 Days of Prayer Points - Adult

- January 11:** Pray that we could reach the unchurched: that people would turn their hearts to God.
- January 12:** Reach those with hardened hearts: Pray that God would work through us to soften the hearts of those who are far away from Him.
- January 13:** That our church would be a place where people can connect and feel loved and accepted.
- January 14:** God's favor: both individually and as a church family.
- January 15:** For our Family Life environments: that we would put an anchor of hope in each child's life that they can never recover from, and that kids would grow closer to God and know Him personally.
- January 16:** For marriages: that God would renew, rebuild, and restore marriages.
- January 17:** For men in the church: Pray that they would have a strong walk with God and have wisdom, courage, and patience.
- January 18:** For women in the church: Pray that they would have a strong walk with God and have wisdom, faithfulness, and joy.
- January 19:** Our military: Pray for their protection and for godly wisdom when dealing with the enemy.
- January 20:** For the president: for his protection, wisdom, and direction.
- January 21:** Safety for our nation and our families.
- January 22:** The unity of our nation and church.
- January 23:** Our government: Pray for wisdom and clarity for those in authority.
- January 24:** For godly relationships that challenge us and keep us accountable.
- January 25:** For wisdom: both individually and for church leaders.
- January 26:** For finances: that God would pour out on His blessings on His people, and that we would be a generous church.
- January 27:** Health and healing: Pray that believers would put their faith in the fact that Jesus can heal them.
- January 28:** Impact Middle East and those doing missionary work around the world.
- January 29:** Boldness: to be bold in teaching the Word and pointing people to Christ.
- January 30:** For our community leaders, our schools, local law enforcement, and first responders.
